CODE OF ETHICS

ACKNOWLEDGING THE SPECIAL CHARACTER OF THE BULL TERRIER, I
AGREE TO ABIDE BY THE FOLLOWING CODE OF ETHICS:

1. Members shall abide by the Constitution and by-laws of the Bull Terrier Club of New England and by the rules that govern The American Kennel Club.
2. Members will neither advocate nor participate in inhumane treatment of any dog. This includes dog fighting, pitting, rolling and/or any activity of such nature.
3. No member will sell Bull Terriers to commercial facilities, business kennels, pet shops, puppy mills puppy brokers, guard dog businesses or any agents thereof.
4. The owner of the brood bitch accepts primary responsibility and a lifetime commitment to the welfare of any dogs bred.
5. The owner of the stud dog recognizes the responsibility and a lifetime commitment to the welfare of any dogs bred.
6. In keeping with breeder responsibility, any breeder who is notified that their dog is in an unsuitable situation, such as mentioned above, and fails to take action to secure a better situation for that dog will be subject to sanction by the Board of Directors.
7. No member shall use for breeding purposes any Bull Terrier who suffers from the following: hip dysplasia, zinc-metabolism syndrome, luxating patella, pyloric dysfunction, severe atopy, entropion, renal disease, deafness, cardiac disorder or any other known genetic defect that can be harmful to the Bull Terrier.
8. No member shall use for breeding purposes any Bull Terrier which displays unpredictable aggression toward humans or does not demonstrate sound behavior or balanced temperament.
9. Members are encouraged to tattoo all puppies and adults and to register the tattoos for purposes of identification or to provide some other means of permanent identification, such as a microchip.
